Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Where are we going today? (Talk together.) I am so thankful God will be with us wherever we go!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, I know You love [name of child] and have plans for them. Help us trust Your plans, because Your plans are always best."



Drive Time

While on the go, take turns naming your favorite foods. Talk about how God had plans for Joseph to save food, and that food saved the lives of A LOT of people, including his own family! God had plans for Joseph, and God has plans for you too.



Bath Time

Add toy food items to bath time. Encourage your child to cook some yummy food. As your child pretends, talk about how God had plans for Joseph to save A LOT of food to feed A LOT of people, including his own family.
